FRAP

Faculty Recruitment Allowance Program (FRAP)

Eligibility

Program

- Full time Senate Faculty
- Primary purpose is support for housing costs. May also support childcare expenses, education or tuition assistance, or similar expenses
- Amount offered mentioned startup letter. Max amount: \$150K

Tax & Repayment implications

- FRAP is considered taxable income. Repayment required if separation occurs, review Dean agreement for details (3 or 5 years)
- Paid via Department

ZIP

Zero Interest Program (ZIP) loan with a forgivable feature

- Full time Senate Faculty
- ZIP Loan can be combined with a primary home loan
- 10% of the loan amount forgiven each year
- Can represent 95% financing of the purchase price
- UCOP max amount: \$150K
- The forgiven amount is reported as taxable income that year on a W-2, subject to standard withholdings.
- ZIP applied at the time of purchase.



Allowable Combinations

HOME LOAN | + | ZIP | + | FRAP

- Can combine FRAP and ZIP for a home purchase
- Home Loan + FRAP + ZIP = Check lender's terms
- When using FRAP+ZIP you can finance <u>UP TO 95%</u> of the purchase price
- I.E. If offered \$100K, Faculty can use \$50K FRAP and \$50K ZIP
- Both FRAP and ZIP are funded by Faculty Start-Up account
- 2 Years from Appointment Start Date to use these programs

How to Apply for a ZIP

Items needed

- Offer Letter or Proposal Letter and Every Expectation Letter (if appt not finalized)
- Start-Up Letter
- Department's AP/HR contact name and email

Book a 1/1 Zoom with HLC

- Discuss loan details with home loan coordinator, where we will discuss the loan application, the pre-approval process as well as the current extended wait times at UCOP
- Once the loan application is submitted by the Faculty member you will be assigned a loan officer who will work on your pre-approval letter (15-20 business days)
